Are you homeless or facing homelessness and need assistance with security deposit or 1st month's rent?

Are you a DC resident?

You may be eligible to receive emergency assistance!

ERAP funds are available to help pay for back rent or security deposit and 1st month's rent for DC residents facing a housing emergency.

In order to apply for assistance, you **must call to schedule an appointment** to attend one of our
