CONFIDENTIAL...

Your confidential information will stay within the clinic.

IMPARTIAL...

Mediators do not decide who is right or wrong; nor do they take sides.

VOLUNTARY...

Mediators do not impose an outcome on the parties.

INFORMAL...

Mediation is not subject to the rules and procedures associated with going to court.

LESS COSTLY...

Financially and emotionally.

ADDITIONAL BENEFITS...

- All mediation services are provided at no cost to the parties, provided income guidelines are met.
- Mediation can happen quickly and efficiently, saving court costs and time.
- Parties actively engage in the resolution of their dispute.
- All participants have an equal and full voice.
- Participation is voluntary.



MEET THE MEDIATORS

- All mediators are law students who have completed extensive training and are supervised by an experienced mediator.
- All mediators are impartial.
- All mediators have an interest in providing mediation services.
- All mediators have flexible schedules and are willing to work with parties' time constraints.
- Mediators do not give legal advice and do not serve as attorneys for the parties.
