Cameron Center, 95 Mahalani Street, Wailuku, Hawai'i 96793  
Group homes (4 locations) for individuals with mental retardation/developmental disabilities. Three homes are Intermediate Care Facilities (ICF) and one home is a licensed Domiciliary Care Home (DOM). 24-hour staff provides life skills training.
- Harvest Chapel Help for Homeless and Needy** ..... 667-1959

Provides meals for the hungry. Can also provide shelter when other resources have been exhausted for the homeless.

Emergency shelter and transitional shelter for men, women and children. Must be unsheltered or in danger of becoming homeless. Both individuals and families are allowed. Case management and education are provided for those in the emergency shelter.

Provides transportation for youths, seniors, and disabled. Public shuttle routes provided on a no-fee, donation basis. Other services include: case management, financial aid, food basket, providing clothing, rent aid, and outreach programs.

Two week crisis shelter for individuals who are in emotional distress and need immediate intervention. Can be associated with a personal crisis, need, or respite or who are in transition to a treatment program or community. Program provides treatment plans, case management, outreach programs and rehabilitation.

 Emergency 10-bed group shelter for youths ages 10 to 17. May stay up to 90 days. The program provides case management, outreach programs, counseling, activities, basic life skills development, and rehabilitation. Also offers emergency satellite shelter home program for youths ages 10 to 17, which is comparable to the group shelter program, but less restrictive and in a family home environment, no fee.

 When funds are available, can provide financial assistance with living costs (rent, utilities, medical, etc.) Food closet, redistribution of donated articles, and counseling also available.

Various extensive services to people in need including drug treatment, counseling, adult day care, and preschool. Also provides showers, lockers, mail, laundry, clothing, health care, case management, food basket, outreach programs, rehabilitation, and emergency financial assistance.

Shelter for women, with or without children, who have experienced domestic abuse. Provides assistance with legal, health, and social service resources. Outreach programs cover Lanai, Hana, and West Maui. Operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Fees: \$ 7.00/ night for women with children over 2 years of age or \$ 5.00/ night for women with children under 2 years of age or without any children. No one is turned away due to lack of funds if she is in danger.
