REINSTATEMENT TIPS

1. Obtain a copy of your driving record for \$6 from www.scdmvonline.com, in-person, or complete the MV-70 Form and return to the SCDMV.
2. Review the report for important information such as dates, ticket numbers, and violations.
3. You may request a “Reinstatement Requirements Document” that explains why your driver’s license is not in good standing and what you need to do before reinstatement.
4. Speak with a representative to determine if you qualify for a payment plan, route restricted driver’s license, provisional license, or temporary alcohol license.

Driver's License Tips

- Did you know that you can change your address online, in-person at an SCDMV branch, or mail?
- Did you know that you must change your name or address with the SCDMV within 10 days of the actual change?
- Did you know that you may be eligible to get back on the road before the suspension period ends?
